"The finish throughout is a combination of European Beech, Tasmanian Myrtle and oak which all compliment each other and the ambience aboard. Cruising any distance and manoeuvring this yacht is pure joy and we can do anything from 2 hour cruises to weekends away or extended trips. With staff included and catering available, the yacht is professionally equipped for entertaining and able to cruise anywhere in the world. Think of it like your own private luxury hotel room with all the amenities you could think of. Basically, if its style, comfort and something a little special you are after – then the PLATINUM is it!" Said Mr Mackeddie.

The three internal levels work well with an individual staircase that leads down to the guest accommodation and a showpiece staircase that takes you to the sky lounge, Jacuzzi and bridge. The cabin deck boasts four double cabins all with their own ensuite. Each cabin is very large with walk-around queen size beds, double wardrobes and portholes to take advantage of the natural light.
